we do have available at our 'Taster Day'.

I am working on a funding application to the Hambleton, Richmondshire & Whitby Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) for money to help us establish a 'Befriending through Sport" pilot project. I have also been busy contacting a number of Charitable Trusts to see if they would support our work, and, just before Christmas we received £1,500 from the Persula Foundation, a very welcome seasonal surprise. Funding through legacies, is, by its very nature, a sensitive subject, but I am keen to talk to some Members to see whether DAG could develop a legacy funding scheme.

Most of us have thoughts about our local health services, and we have arranged a **Coffee Morning for Members** to come along and give your views on community health services in Whitby and the redevelopment proposals for Whitby Hospital. Representatives from Hambleton, Whitby & Richmondshire CCG will be there to get your feedback on these important issues on **4**th **March**, **here at Church House between 10.00am – 12.00noon**.

You can also contribute to the guide by adding your own review of a cinema, bar, sports ground, station, holiday resort, or anywhere else you would like to tell people about.



Travel can be challenging for everyone but it can be more so for disabled people. The Foreign and Commonwealth Office publication, "Disabled Travellers", contains advice and information to help make your travels easier.


